**General Fee Schedule - (1/2/06)**

**1. Transfer Station Recycling Sticker**

**Primary Sticker = \$35.00**

**Additional Sticker = \$2.00**

**2. Per Bag Fee** – As of January 1, 2006, the Town of Worthington will use a punch card system for the disposal of household trash. The “Green” punch cards are for the smaller bags (\$.50) of trash and the “Red” punch cards are for the larger bags (\$1.00) of trash. The punch cards are available at the Town Hall, by mail from the Town, and at the Corners Grocery store.

Residents will no longer give cash directly to the attendant  
for the disposal of household trash!

**Red Punch Card = (20) 30 Gallon Bags - @\$1.00/each = \$20.00**

**Green Punch Card = (20) 15 Gallon Bags - @\$0.50/each = \$10.00**

**3. Larger Loads - The fees for car or pickup truck loads are as follows:**

Station Wagon/Van = \$35.00

Regular Pickup Truck = \$ 75.00

Compact Pickup Truck = \$ 50.00

Please put material in open top box on site.

\* (No large dump truck loads, allowed) For larger loads call the Northampton DPW at (413) 587 - 1570 or the HRMC at (413) 268 -3845 or a local hauler.

**4. Large Item Disposal Fees (each)**

Mattress = \$10.00

Box Spring = \$10.00

Couches (2 or more seats) = \$15.00

Stuffed Chairs = \$10.00

Recliner Chair = \$15.00

Misc. large items (chairs, rugs, etc.) = \$10.00

Misc. smaller items (chairs, rugs, etc.) = \$5.00

Misc. Toilet, sinks tubs, etc. = \$20.00

Misc. Cabinets Etc. = \$5.00

Scrap lumber /Doors = \$10.00

The price for unlisted items determined by the attendant.

**5. Large Metal Item Recycling Fees (each)**

Refrigerators/Freezers/Air Conditioners = \$25.00\*

\*(Priced to include fee to the Town for freon removal)

Washing Machines = \$15.00

Dryers, Stoves, etc. = \$15.00

Water Tanks = \$25.00

Microwaves = \$5.00

Wood Stoves, Bulky Items, or equivalent = \$10.00

Propane tanks = \$3.00

The price for unlisted items determined by the attendant.

**6. Tire Disposal Fees**

Passenger = \$3.00

Passenger with rim = \$4.00

Truck Tire (over 18 inches) = \$10.00

Truck Tire with rim = \$12.00

For larger tires contact the HRMC at (413) 268 - 3845

**7. Household Recycling (No charge)** - There is no charge for the recycling of Bottles, cans, plastic containers, cardboard and paper items (See list on back of handout).

**8. Paint Recycling (No charge)** - The Town of Worthington has paint recycling available to residents. Please bring (1/2 full or better) cans of latex paint, stain, or oil based paint only ! Available May 1st and October 15th.

**9. Compost Bins (\$25.00 apiece)** - The Town of Worthington has backyard compost bins for sale at the transfer station. The bins cost \$25.00 apiece and are made of 50% recycled plastic .

**10. Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)** - The Hilltown Resource Management Cooperative runs a regional HHW collection every fall (On or about October 30). Residents are allowed to drop off one box of HHW (Oven cleaners, drain cleaners, photo chemicals, nail polish remover, pesticides, herbicides, automotive chemicals, paint thinners etc.) at a central site, at no charge on the collection day.

**11. Electronics Recycling (Computers & Televisions)** -

Under this program televisions, computer monitors, computer CPU's, other computer components are collected;

Computer Screen & Printers and CPU's = \$5.00

Regular Size Television Sets - \$5.00

Console or Large Screen Television Set = \$20.00

**12. Oil Recycling** - Town of Worthington residents may bring used motor oil for recycling. You are to required check with the attendant before pouring oil into the collection tank. This tank is for oil only! No gasoline, antifreeze or other contaminates allowed. The waste oil is used to heat the Town highway garage.

**13. Miscellaneous (Other recycling programs available)**

Car Batteries – Program is under review at this time.

Salvation Army Box (free) - Available at site for old clothes etc.

## **Paper Products**

Newspapers, Magazines & Circulars  
Corrugated Cardboard  
Brown Paper Bags  
Paperboard Boxes  
Office, Computer and Colored paper  
Phone Books (**No Covers**)  
All Junk Mail and Envelopes

**No Pizza Boxes, Egg Cartons or Waxed Cardboard**

**These products can be mixed together.  
Please flatten all boxes and paper.  
Please put them in the properly marked container.**

## **Container Products**

Tin Cans (soup , cat food, etc.)  
Aluminum Cans and clean Foil  
All Green, Clear and Brown Glass Jars and Bottles  
Milk Cartons and Juice Packs  
All Plastic Containers (#1 - #7 - includes  
juice, soap, water, milk, etc.)

**No window glass, aerosol cans, light bulbs, ceramics, plastic bags or styrofoam !**

**These products can be mixed together.  
Please rinse all containers.  
Please flatten all your cans, plastic bottles, and milk cartons.  
Please put them in the properly marked container.  
Flattening helps the Town save money !  
Recycling is mandatory and you must have a valid Town  
vehicle permit to use the recycling services.**
